

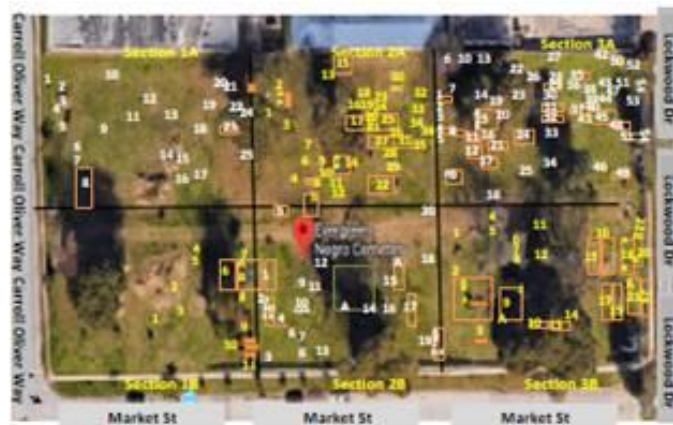

### Project(s) Overview:

We will be focused on assisting with restoration efforts at a historic cemetery. Since the cemetery is indeed 'historic' there are limitations to what we can do – there will be no cleaning of headstones, use of power tools, etc. Below is a map of the cemetery.



### Project List:

- 1) Lay mulch around trees that lie within the cemetery (there are well over 100).
- 2) Plant flowers and lay mulch around the trees that line the streets (there are about 50).
- 3) Place flower spikes next to the headstones and flags by those that belong to veterans (someone will be there to show which belong to veterans).
- 4) Pick up litter.

Volunteers will divide in half with one group starting at the east end of the cemetery on Carrol Oliver while the other group starts at the west end at Sakowitz then work toward meeting in the middle.

- [UHD's Beta Sigma Chapter of Omega Delta Phi Fraternity, Inc.](#) will oversee the planting of flowers.
- [UHD's Women's Soccer Club](#), led by President Jasmin Rendon, will work as a team to provide mulch to volunteers via wheelbarrows.
